4.- COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES.

COMPARATIVES:

- ◆ 1.- Igualdad: **As+ adjective + As:** *John is as tall as George.*
- ◆ 2.- Superioridad: **1 syllable Adjective+er + than.** *Peter is taller than María.*
 Adjective ending in CVC → CVCC
 Madrid is **bigger** than Salamanca
2 syllables Adjective ending in y > ier
Maggie is prettier than his sister.
3 or more syllables → more+Adjective + than
The chair is more comfortable than the sofa..
- ◆ 3.- Inferioridad : **Less + Adjective + than.** *He is less intelligent than his daughter.*

SUPERLATIVES:

- ▶ **1 syllable The + Adjective + est.** *Peter is the tallest.*
 → Adjective ending in CVC → CVCC
 July is the **hottest** month of the year
- ▶ **2 syllables: the + Adjective ending in y > iest .-** *Maggie is the prettiest.*
- ▶ **3 or more syllables The most + Adjective.** *This chair is the most comfortable of all.*
