<b>NAME</b>	What's your name?	My name is .....
<b>SURNAME</b>	What's your surname?	My surname is .....
<b>ORIGIN</b>	Where are you from?	I'm from.....
<b>AGE</b>	How old are you?	I'm ..... years old
<b>BIRTHDAY</b>	When is your birthday?	It is on the .....of .....
<b>INTERESTS</b>	What are your hobbies? What do you like doing?	My hobbies are.....and ..... I like + Ving.- "I like reading"
<b>FAVOURITES</b>	What's your favourite...? ( singer/ band /food/colour/ team / season/ actor/actress)	My favourite ..... is/are

### 3.- HOW TO ASK FOR THINGS.

**Q.** Can I borrow your .....? ( dictionary, notebook, pencil case, make up , car)  
Can I have..... ( some water, your telephone number,.....)

**NOTE:** Could is also possible, but it's more formal  
Could I borrow your car, please?

**A.-** - Sure.  
- Of course.  
- Go ahead. ( claro, adelante)  
- Help yourself ( sírvete)  
- Here you are ( aquí tienes)  
- No, you can't. I'm sorry

**May I** .....

**A.-** - Sure.  
- Of course.
