furry coat you have on."

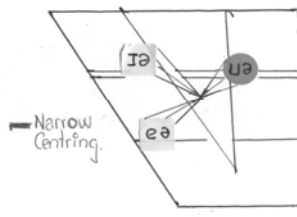
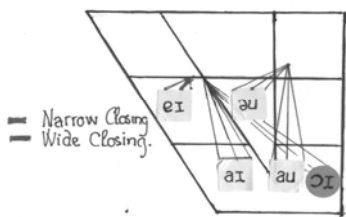
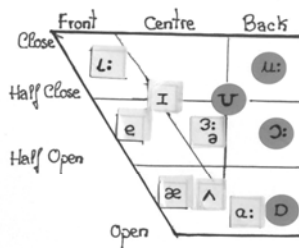
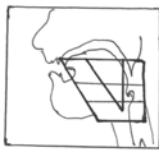
"That's wrong!" cried Wolf.
